EXEMPTION CLASSIFICATION

In 2022, the Utah Legislature established <u>Utah Code 73-10-34</u>, mandating all pressurized secondary connections be metered at the end user by January 1st, 2030. Within this code, secondary water providers can seek an exemption from this mandate.

Four exemption options are available. The first three exemptions listed are filed through the Division of Water Resources (Subsections 9, 10, and 11). Subsection 13 is filed through the Division of Water Rights.

EXEMPTION (Subsection 9)

Secondary water provider agrees to:

- 1. submit documentation to the Division of Water Resources that the cost of purchasing, installing, and upgrading systems to accept meters exceeds 25% of the water provider's total operating budget;
- 2. not add a new secondary water connection to the secondary water supplier's system on or after May 4, 2022;
- 3. provide a Water Conservation Plan (WCP) to the Division of Water Resources within six months of seeking exemption;
- 4. report to the Division of Water Resources on their WCP annually; and
- 5. submit to evaluations by the Division of Water Resources of the effectiveness of their WCP.

EXEMPTION (Subsection 10)

Secondary water provider agrees to:

- 1. submit reasonable proof to the Division of Water Resources that the secondary water provider is unable to obtain a meter;
- 2. provide a Water Conservation Plan to the Division of Water Resources within six months of declaring exemption;
- 3. report to the Division of Water Resources annually; and
- 4. submit to evaluations by the Division of Water Resources of the effectiveness of the Water Conservation Plan.
