


#### Soil Moisture Trends (Column; 3-month)




3-Month Difference in Column Relative Soil Moisture (%




## Current reservoir levels 78% Median 55.4% Last year 43%










## Current Storage




#### Weather Forecast Office Utah Day 1-7 Outlook




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#### Weather Prediction Center U.S. Day 3-7 Hazards Outlook











Climate Prediction Center 8 to 14 Day Outlooks - Temperature

#### Climate Prediction Center 8 to 14 Day Outlooks - Precipitation







## **Utah Area-Based Runoff Duration Hydrograph**




The Runoff Duration Hydrograph is a graphical presentation of area-based runoff (the black line) calculated as a weighted average of HUC 8-runoff, plotted over the long-term statistics of runoff for each day or month of the year for each area.

Daily value 12/11/2023 = 4,192.4'


- Peaked at 4,194.0' on 6/19 and 6/20/2023







Fall soil moisture conditions throughout Utah improved significantly over last year, which is beneficial towards a more efficient runoff.
