An interactive assessment for participants interested in forming a Statutory Water Bank that asks participants to assess their expertise, capacity, and interest in completing each of the required, necessary, and optional tasks needed to establish a Statutory Water Bank under the Utah Water Banking Act. This document is intended to identify which parties are most appropriate to complete each task and assess the overall interest and ability of the group to establish a Statutory Water Bank. The Statutory Water Bank Participant Assessment is to be used in concert with the Statutory Water Bank Summary of Tasks and Responsibilities.
