POLICY REGARDING COST-SHARING:

The applicant may request American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) grant funds up to 60% of the total project cost. If the applicant cannot cover the remaining 40% cost-share, the applicant may request financing assistance through the Board of Water Resources' revolving loan funds up to 34% of the total project cost. The Board's financing will be repaid at 1% interest over a period not to exceed five years less than the warranty on the meters. The remaining is expected to be paid by the applicant. The Board's share of the project will also include a nominal administrative fee for costs incurred by the Division of Water Resources for project administration. This fee will be included in the feasibility report presented to the Board. The Board's cost-share will be repaid by the applicant according to the terms set by the Board of Water Resources at the time funds are committed to the project. The administrative fee will not be charged if the project is found infeasible, denied by the Board, or if the application is withdrawn.
