NPS Cmt 104	The NPS requests that the analysis include and identify regional air quality data for the area of Page; cumulative effects from the Navajo Generating Station need to be analyzed.	Regarding the cumulative effects from the Navajo Generating Station, our analysis shows there would be no cumulative effects. The bullet list comprising Section 5.3.17.2.2 - Potential Effects Eliminated from Further Analysis, Chapter 5, Exhibit E of the License Application is revised to add the following bullet: Prevailing winds in the Page, Arizona area come from the west and carry emissions from the Page area and Navajo Generating Station (NGS) east away from the LPP area. Construction emissions from the LPP would rapidly dissipate to undetectable levels within less than one mile from the alignment and facility locations. Therefore, there would be no cumulative effects of the LPP with emissions in the Page area and with NGS emissions.	air
